The kick-off meeting of RELIVET “Reducing Early Leaving in VET” project took place in Rethymno on the 5th to 6th of November 2018. The project is funded by the Erasmus+ program KA2 Strategic Partnerships for VET.

The project involves seven partners from five different countries, coordinated by the European Centre for Socio professional

Integration ACTA-Romania.

The other partners are: European Education and Learning Institute – EELI (Greece), Consorzio Ro.ma (Italy) ETIC – School of Technologies, Innovation and Creation (Portugal), EU TRADE (Lithuania), Inercia Digital (Spain), ITI “Augusto Righi” (Italy).

During this first meeting, the working tasks for the following working months

were described and assigned.

Also, the general aspects of the Project Management, Dissemination and Quality requirements had the consensus according the approved proposal.



A PROJECT OVERVIEW

The main aim of the RELiVET project is to identify the factors that lead students to drop out from regional VET schools in each participating country of the project as well as the existing training programmes for professionals regarding prevention techniques on VET and their contents.

Target Group

Students and VET teachers, educators, related professionals and families of the students, in order to identify young people at risk of dropping out and apply intervention methods to prevent early leaving from education and training.

Based on the research findings, partners will design a training curriculum for teachers in VET education, as well as for the special scientific staff involved in the learning process, on effective strategies for increasing graduation rates and student attainment.
